DRONE FLIGHT ZONES AROUND SALEM

Most of Salem sits in FAA-controlled airspace — and that means not every drone flight is automatic. But thanks to LAANC (Low Altitude Authorization and Notification Capability), licensed pilots can often get near-instant approval to fly.

AIRSPACE EXAMPLES



North Salem

Auto-Approval: Varies FAA Authorized: 400 ft



Keizer

Uncontrolled airspace in most areas — approved for 400 ft



East Salem

50 - 200 ft With FAA Authorization: 400 ft



Central Salem

0 - 50 ft

With FAA Authorization: 400 ft

TOTAL PROOF TO SERVICE AND SE

- Most of Salem is controlled airspace
- 100-200 ft flights: Usually instant approval
- 300-400 ft flights: Submit 72+ hours in advance
- Red zones (KSLE vicinity): Flights not permitted
- FAA Part 107 pilots required for legal listing shoots



Drone Altitude Zones Around Salem

Understanding FAA Grid Approvals and Where You Can Fly Near KSLE (Salem Airport)



- Red: No-Fly Zones (0 ft ceiling) typically around KSLE airport. Drone flights not permitted without a waiver.
- Blue: Controlled Airspace FAA authorization required above the auto-approval altitude shown (e.g., 50, 100, 200 ft). Further FAA approval up to 400 ft may be granted with coordination (typically within 72 hours).
- Orange: Class E Airspace Additional airspace shelves requiring coordination for drone operations.
- White: Class G (Uncontrolled) Airspace. Flying in white areas? Good news no authorization needed. We can fly up to 400 ft immediately.
- ¶ Altitude Labels on the map (50, 100, 200, etc.) indicate the maximum height allowed without additional coordination.

FAA may approve flights above the auto-approval ceiling — up to 400 ft — when requested at least 72 hours in advance by a licensed drone pilot.
